



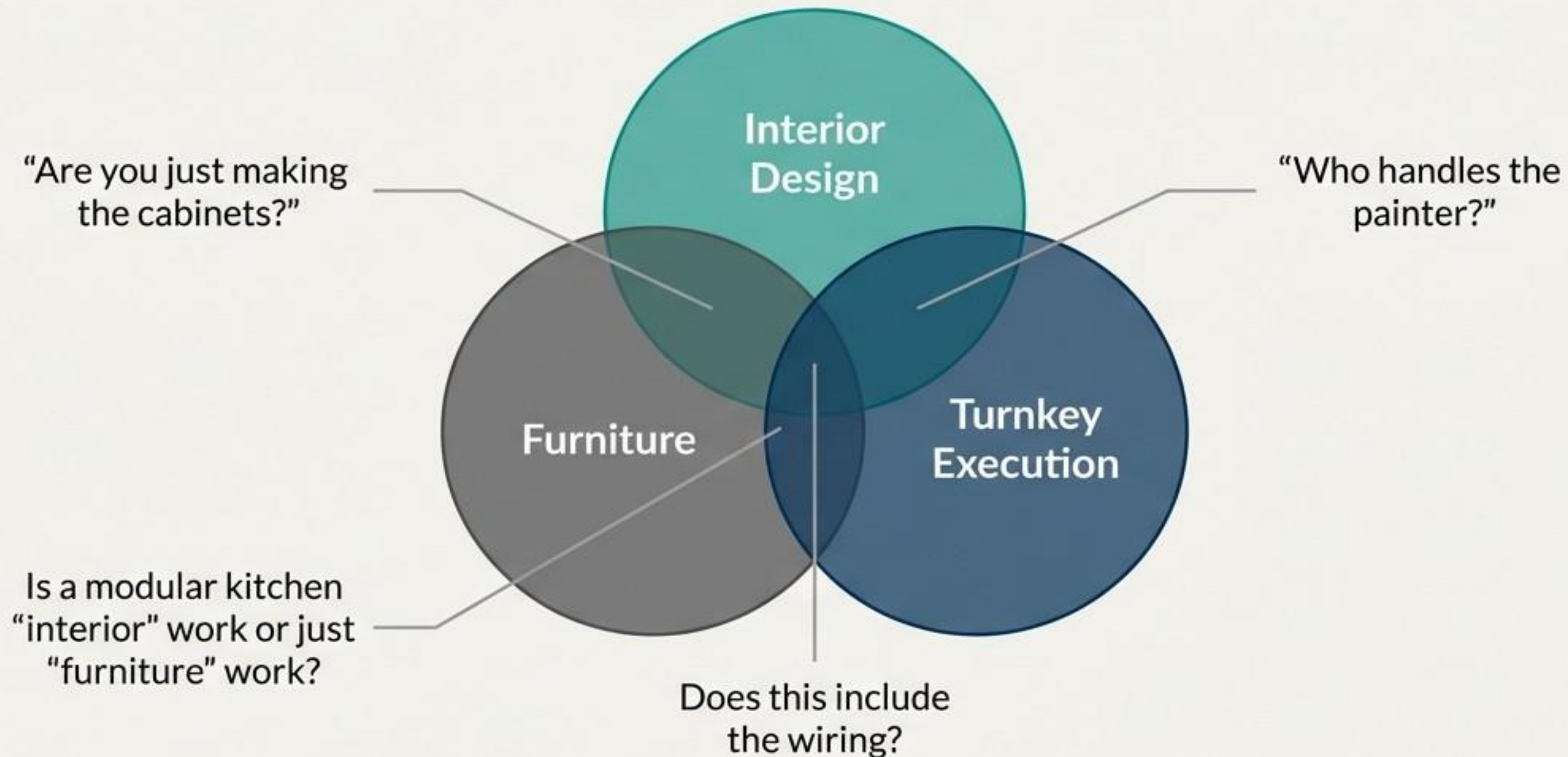

The Anatomy of a Project

Defining Your Scope: From a Single Piece to a Complete Space

“I need interiors done.” What does that actually mean?



Mismatched expectations often lead to budget overruns and project delays. Clarity is the key to success.

The Three Paths to Your Perfect Space



Furniture Work

Focused on fabricating and installing specific items.



Interior Work

Focused on designing and finishing the aesthetics of a space.



Turnkey Project

Focused on managing the entire project from shell to handover.

Path 1: Focusing on the Essentials

The 'Buying Pre-made Ingredients' Approach

What it includes

The design, manufacturing, and installation of custom fixed and loose furniture. (e.g., Modular Kitchens, Wardrobes, TV Units, Custom Tables). Includes material selection, finishes, and hardware.

What it does NOT include

Civil or structural work, electrical, plumbing, false ceilings, wall painting, flooring, or overall space planning.

Your Role: HIGH INVOLVEMENT

You are the project manager. You must coordinate with all other vendors (electricians, painters, civil contractors) and manage timelines and quality across multiple parties.



Is Furniture Work the Right Fit for You?

Lato Regular: When is this the perfect choice?



You're doing targeted upgrades

You only need specific furniture items for a room that is otherwise complete.



You are a hands-on manager

You are comfortable coordinating multiple teams and managing the overall project timeline yourself.



Your basic structure is ready

All civil, electrical, and plumbing work is already finished, and you just need the final furniture elements.



You are budget-conscious

This approach allows you to control costs by hiring vendors for specific jobs.



Path 2: Crafting a Cohesive Experience

The 'Meal Kit' Approach

What it includes

A professional design plan plus the execution of all aesthetic elements. This covers both furniture (built-in and loose) and the finishes that create a complete look.

The Focus

Aesthetics, functionality, and space optimization. The designer coordinates the aesthetic vendors but not typically the heavy civil work.

Your Role: MEDIUM INVOLVEMENT

You approve the design vision and major decisions. The designer manages the execution and coordination of the aesthetic teams, but you may need to manage separate contractors for major structural changes.



The Scope of Interior Work

- ✓ Custom & Modular Furniture
- ✓ False Ceiling & Lighting Design
- ✓ Electrical Points & Lighting Fixtures
- ✓ Wall Finishes (Paint, Texture, Wallpaper, Cladding)
- ✓ Space Planning & Layout Optimization
- ✓ Flooring (in some cases)

Important Note

Typically does NOT include heavy civil work, major plumbing rerouting, or significant structural changes.

Path 3: From Bare Walls to ‘Welcome Home’

The ‘Hiring a Private Chef’ Approach

What it is

A single contract and a single point of contact for the entire project. One team manages everything from initial plans to final handover.

The Key Benefit

A fully coordinated timeline, unified quality control, and fewer surprises. Ideal for busy professionals or families who want a seamless experience.

Your Role: LOW INVOLVEMENT

You are the decision-maker, not the day-to-day manager. Your role is to approve plans and then move into a finished space.
